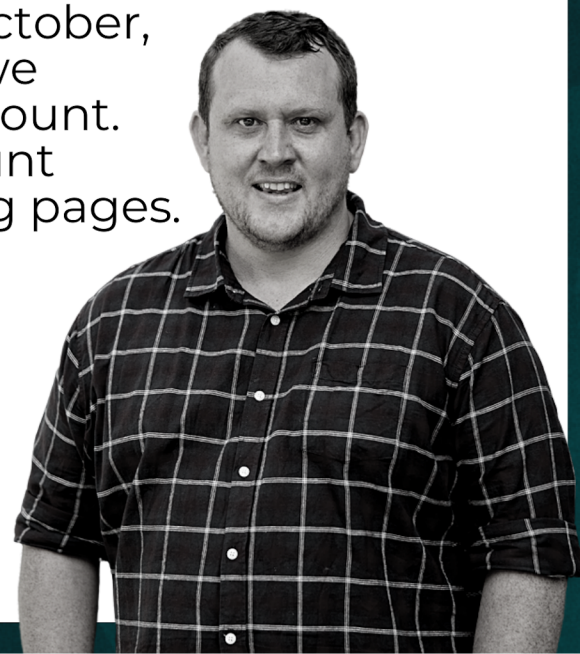

The target amount that the Church Council have prayed about and feel called to this financial year is **\$125,000**. Although not an insurmountable amount, we will certainly need God's help in reaching this goal.

Last financial year, we were immensely blessed and were able to raise over \$150,000 which was \$50,000 more than our goal. We were immensely encouraged by this, however are also aware that times are difficult for many people with cost of living having increased substantially over the past 12 months. Although this is the case, we're believing that God will again work through His people, whilst trying to be wise.

We will be sharing more details about this, but the thing you can do straight away is pray about what God might have you give. No gift is insignificant and we encourage you to faithfully seek God in giving to the vision of the church.



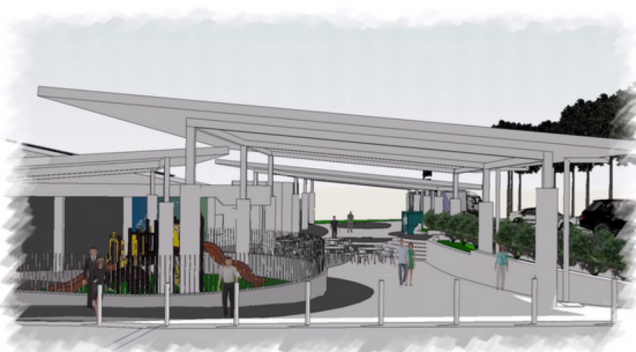
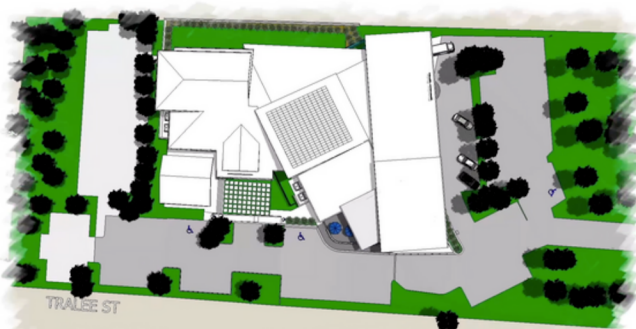
